After Manchester's grim debacle in the third round of the FA Cup at Bournemouth, manager Ron Atkinson is adamant that winning the Canon League is more important than any knock out cup victory. With the 1st XI out of the UAU Roger Cantello, team captain, is seeking similar solace in the Devon and Exeter League.

The UAU might not have the glamour of the FA Cup but Exeter's departure from the competition was a cruel blow to the 1st XI who were seeking to improve on their quarter-final loss of 1982-83. unavailable'. He added to that by saying 'We're a better balanced side than last year when we finished as runners up, and I will be disappointed if we don't finish as winners of the league'. Roger was happy that Neil Hicks would be available for Saturday matches after his match with Exeter City came to nothing. The professional side, who stand before the abyss of relegation this season failed to get in contact with Hicks after last term's match. Their loss is Cantello's gain as Neil has found the back of the net 18 times so far this season.

The 2nd XI are not having the same league success that the first team are enjoying. They are near the bottom of their division, although, like all university teams they have a lot of games in hand. They and the 3rd XI are putting more emphasis on the UAU as neither side could be promoted because of a league rule that prohibits more than one team from the same club from being in the same division.
