

Olga Sánchez Cordero

Mexico's first female Secretary of the Interior. She was the first woman to become Mexico City's—then Federal District—notary public through an examination. Sánchez holds a bachelor's degree in law from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), and has postgraduate studies in social policy and administration at the University College of Swansea in the United Kingdom. She was elected as a member of Mexico City's Constituent Assembly in 2016. Sánchez served as Justice of the National Supreme Court of Justice (1995 – 2015), and of Mexico City's—then Federal District—Supreme Court of Justice (1993 – 1995). She is the author of various publications, and, since 1975, she has lectured numerous law courses at several universities in Mexico.
